THE DAZZLE

Hilary Harnischfeger's art captivates the eye and seduces the senses. Her green-tinted and swirling asymmetrical ceramics, their amazing slanting surfaces embedded with bits of turquoise, pyrite, and something called Herkimer diamonds, are sculptures by another name. Her wall works—shifting abstract planes inlaid with paper, plaster, and crushed glass—conjure topological maps, archaic faces, lapidary wonders from the Orient, and geological plates in motion. They're more than paintings; they exude magical allure (at Rachel Uffner through June 19).
