If Moyer's forbiddingly beautiful paintings evoke post-apocalyptic landscapes, consider her process: after drenching a canvas with India ink, Moyer attacks it with bleach, manipulating the fabric so that its folds and creases resemble an aerial view of a crater or a turbulent, alien ocean. One series here, titled "Slackliner," is composed of slightly skewed stripes that pay subtle (perhaps inadvertent) homage to Jasper Johns's iconic flag, with scattered splotches mimicking stars.
