### Rachel Uffner Gallery

An early pioneer of the LES gallery scene Rachel Uffner opened her first space in 2008. She recently moved from her original Orchard Street location to her current outpost on Suffolk Street. The newly renovated building has an airy, garage aesthetic that combines Chelsea chic with downtown vintage. Over the years, she has accrued a roster of 11 promising emerging artists including Sam Moyer and Vlatka Horvat. This summer, they made a foray into the established practice of presenting historical shows with their group exhibit The Crystal Palace, containing works by Joseph Cornell and James Rosenquit. This venture coupled with the rising reputation of her artists further solidifies Rachel Uffner as a gallerina to watch.
