Although I'm not much of a Jeff Koons fan, my favorite piece is his reinterpretation of the famous Balloon Dog. I also really like his new series of abstract aluminum works. I know from experience that bringing these pieces from concept to creation is anything but easy and I think it's fantastic that he is continuing to develop his relationship with the medium. I can't wait to see how far he's taken it a few years from now.
