ART WORLD/10 UPCOMING SHOWS BY GROUNDBREAKING FEMALE ARTISTS



Today is International Women's Day and March is Women's History Month, so there's no better time to outline a few upcoming shows by female artists we admire. From Hong Kong to Los Angeles, 2016 is brimming with exhibitions by awesome artists, who range in age from twentysomethings to one very impressive centenarian.

Linn Meyers, "Our View From Here" at the Hirshhorn Museum:

Linn Meyers, a Washington, DC-based artist, will create her largest site-specific work to date inside the spiraling inner-circle galleries of the Hirshhorn. The massive, 360-degree wall drawing will stretch the circumference of the second-level space—over 400 linear feet—and will feature thousands of detailed, rippling lines that require hours of work to produce. Meyers is currently in the process of creating the work, and following its yearlong exhibition, it will be painted over. "Our View From Here" will be on display from May 12, 2016–May 14, 2017.
